Juror- Tom Zwierlein, studio artist and visual arts coordinator, has been teaching art at Lovett and Callanwolde Arts Center in Atlanta since 1987. He taught at University of Kentucky and has been a visiting artist at many craft schools and colleges, including The Penland School, the Hambidge Center, and the Georgia High School Governor's Honors Program at Valdosta State. Mr. Zwierlein was a founding faculty member of the Anderson Ranch Ceramics Program in the late 1970s under the direction of Paul Soldner, and is a contributing writer for the international ceramic magazine Clay Times.

This is open to artists working in any media. Venue expected to be Surry Community College and Elkin Recreation Park/ Yadkin Valley Clay Works and will take place from 10 AM till 4 PM on Saturday and Sunday, April 5 and 6, 2008.

A limited number of participants will be offered the opportunity to attend the workshop "hands on" and lecture as equipment for each artist to take photos of their work is also limited.
